## Finances

Just a reminder that your December tuition will be the same amount as it is in other months. In our budgeting process, we determine the amount of annual tuition that is required and then divide that total amount by nine (9) to arrive at your monthly tuition. Regular tuition, monthly Early Bird tuition and monthly tigger Time tuition is due by the first of each month and considered late if not received in the preschool office by the 10th of the month. The late payment fee is now \$25 and will be added to your accounts for payments received after the late date. For those of you who prepaid the first half of the year's tuition in September, please note that the second payment will be due by January 15, 2016. You will be sent a reminder by the end of the year as to the amount of the second payment.
